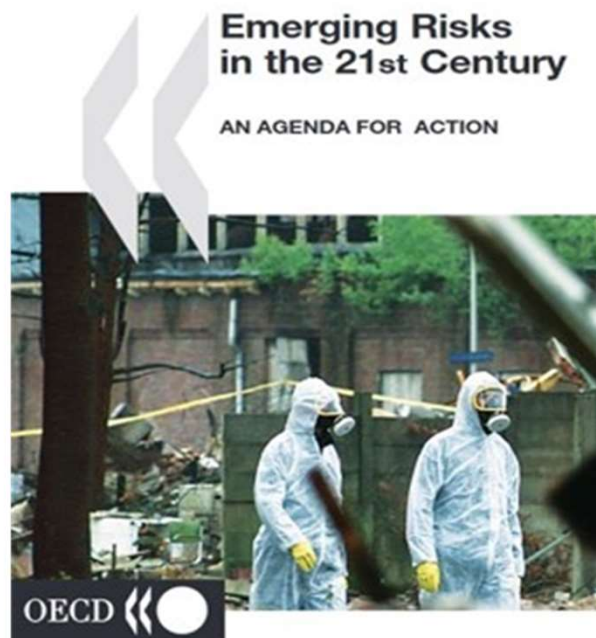


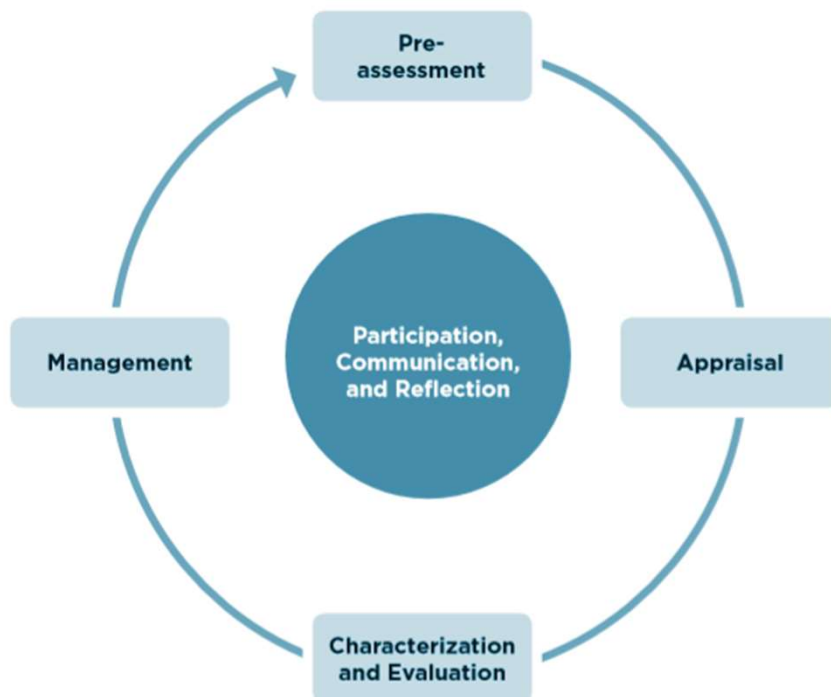

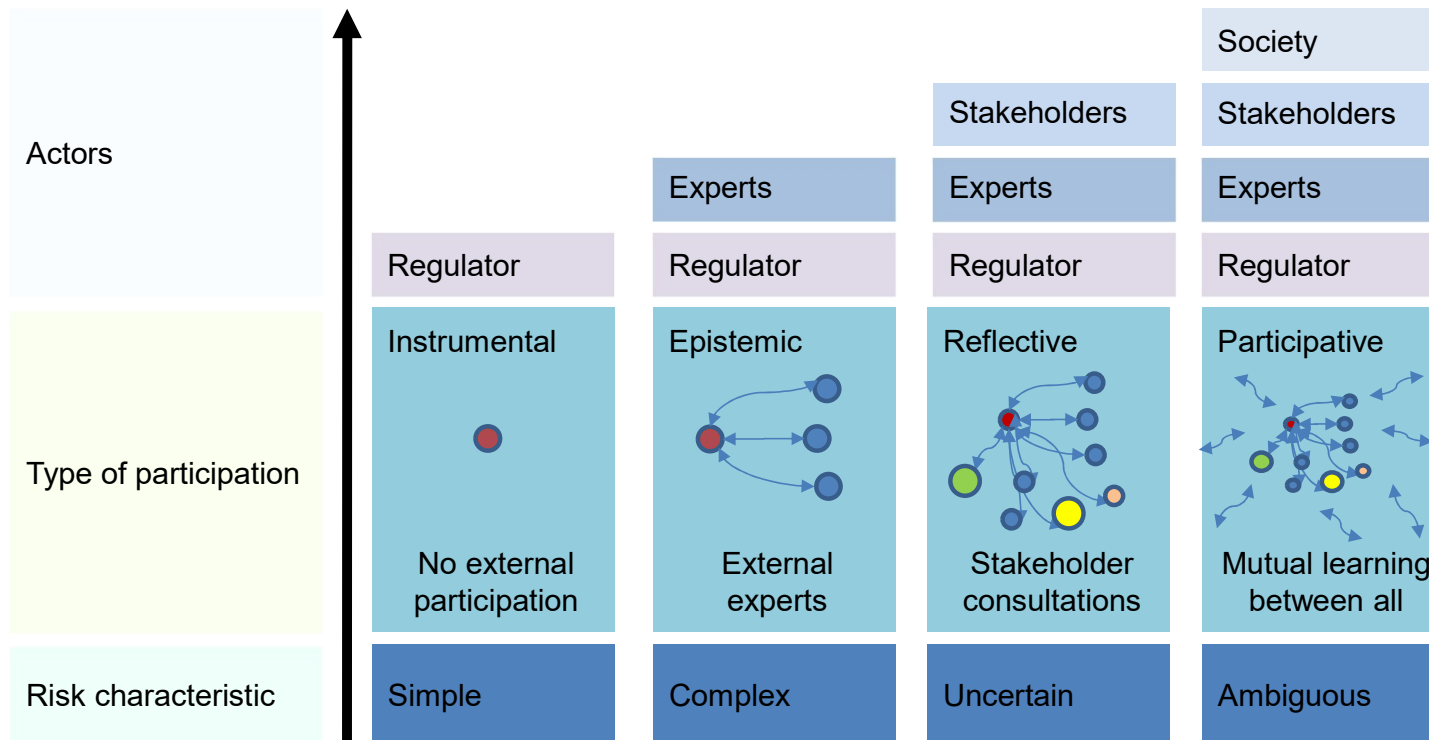


“Every day, **people** face a variety of risks that may result in **damage to what they value**: their life, their health, the lives and health of others, their property, or the environment. Some of these risks affect individuals but have only an isolated impact on society – car accidents are an example. Others, however, may be on a much **larger scale** and their effects **may spread much further**. This report is concerned with the latter, more specifically, **with those risks that affect the systems on which society depends – health, transport, environment, telecommunications, etc.**” (OECD 2003, p. 9)
